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Description of Change to the Customer:

The Intel products listed in the Products Affected table will undergo the following changes:

1. The updated transceiver integrates multiple discrete components within the module into a single IC, while the optical sub-assemblies are migrated from TO-can to Chip-on-flex. The maximum power consumption is reduced ~0.2W.
2. Mechanically, the EMI collar is laser-welded (previously wrap around).
3. Customers can expect to receive either of the following optics installed in their product, as this optic is dual sourced. The Intel PN on the optic label will be updated from E65689-003 to E65689-005, and the supplier PN will be updated per the table and photos below:
