The D2500CC CPU will be converting from B2 to B3 stepping.

Customer Impact of Change and Recommended Action:

1. It has been observed that the change to the new B3 stepping reports a "New device Detected" in some operating systems. Microsoft* Windows will display a message and automatically install the necessary drivers; however, customers may wish to update their OS image to avoid the message.
2. For B3 stepping, the CPU should use the Gfx driver V.1083 or later version.

These changes have been thoroughly evaluated to ensure there is no quality, reliability, or functional implication to our customers. Intel is not recommending additional qualification of these changes on platforms received from Intel.
