This PCN is being sent to inform you of important changes regarding your Intel demodulator and tuner product offering, and procurement process for the Zarlink RF Front-End Consumer Business acquired by Intel Corporation.

Any orders with line items scheduled to ship on or after May 8th, 2006, will be transferred to Intel's order fulfillment system and will be fulfilled by Intel.

Beginning April 10th, 2006, all new orders requesting shipment on May 8th, 2006, and later, will be processed using Intel's SAP order fulfillment system and should use the Intel ordering code. Please see table below.

We'd like to inform you of product marking and packing changes. For a period of time after the transition is completed on May 8th, 2006, you will receive product in either Zarlink or Intel packaging. Please

refer to the packaging options below and be sure to make note of these changes in your systems for receipt and data quality purposes.

All Zarlink marked products will have a Zarlink box, package and label. When inventory runs out, we begin shipping the Intel marked products.

All Intel marked products will have an Intel box, package and label. Please see examples of the label below.

All products will have an Intel label which contains information such as: MM#, marketing name, lot number, etc... For the Zarlink products, this will be an additional label leaving the original Zarlink label visible.

The actual format of the Intel mark diagrams will vary for each package type. In general, each new product mark will include an Intel "i" logo, the marketing product name (and S-Spec, if applicable), the lot number, a maskworks/copyright line, and a Pb-free indicator (if applicable). More specific marking information for all products will be sent in a subsequent communication. Please contact your Local Intel Field Sales Representative for support if further information is needed.
