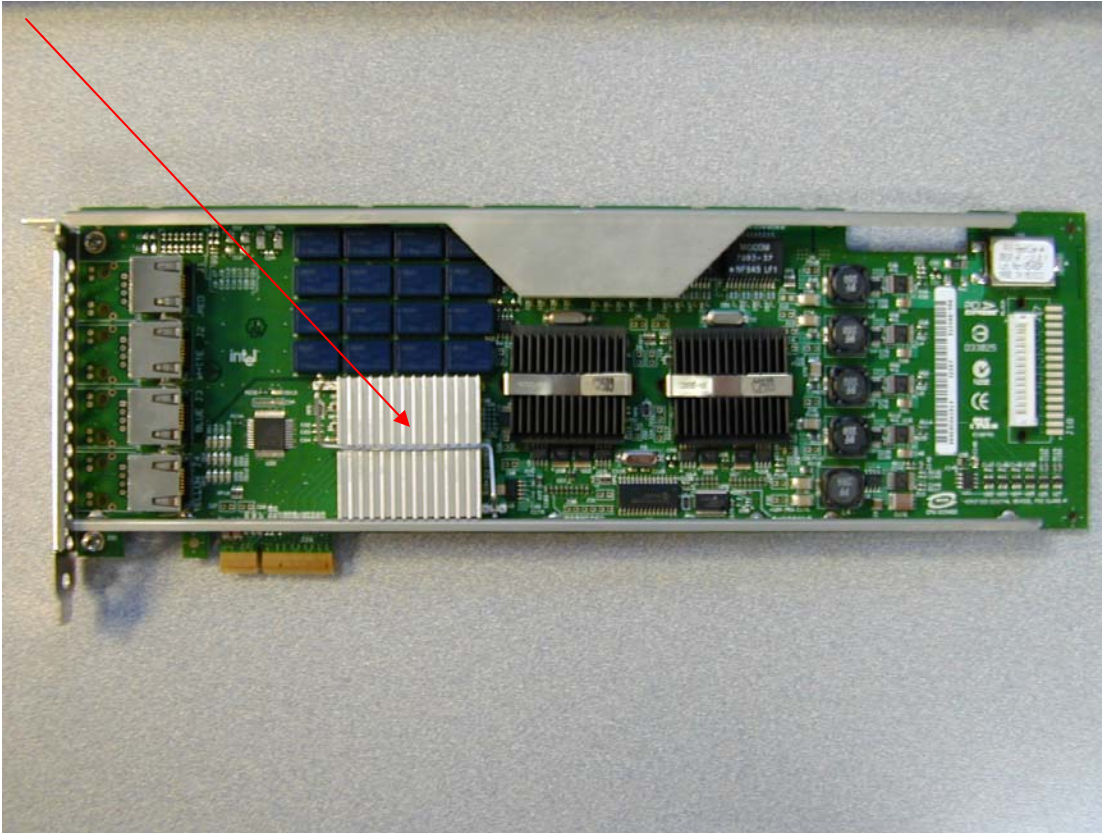

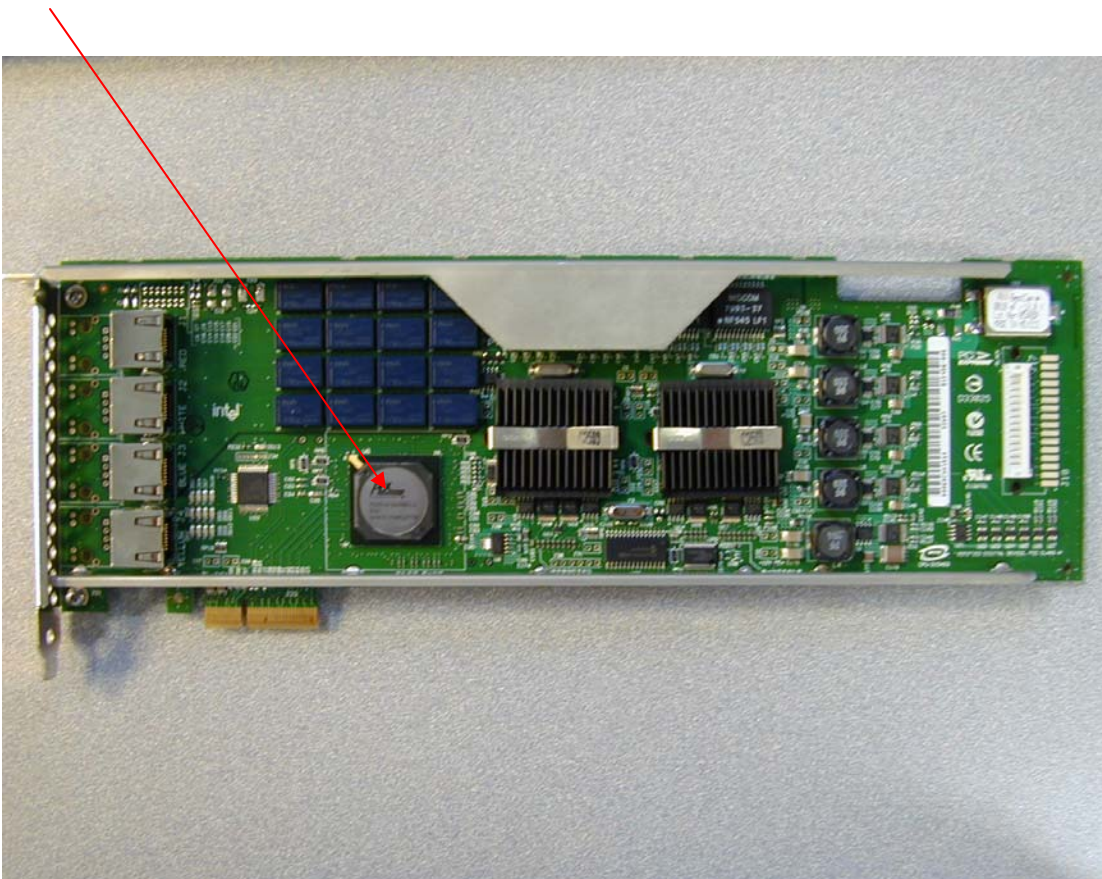
The Intel PRO/1000 PT Quad Port Bypass Adapter, EXPI9014PTBLK MM#876697 and EXPI9024PTBLK MM#876699, Dewey Beach ByPass & NIF (NIC in Front), as noted in the affected products table within this PCN notification, will undergo the following changes:

- Intel will remove one heat sink and clip from the PLX Bridge switch, as noted in the pictures below.

- The EEPROM, TA & PBA numbers will also roll.

Customer Impact of Change and Recommended Action:

The Heat sink and clip are being removed because they are unnecessary. This will not change the performance of the product.

Testing on the Dewey Beach PLX switch without the heat sink showed the following results; the highest no air flow case temperature recorded with no heat sink was 65 degrees Centigrade. Customers who wish to obtain more testing data, can contact their local Intel Field Sales representative.

Customers might expect to receive mixed inventory, until current inventory levels are depleted.
