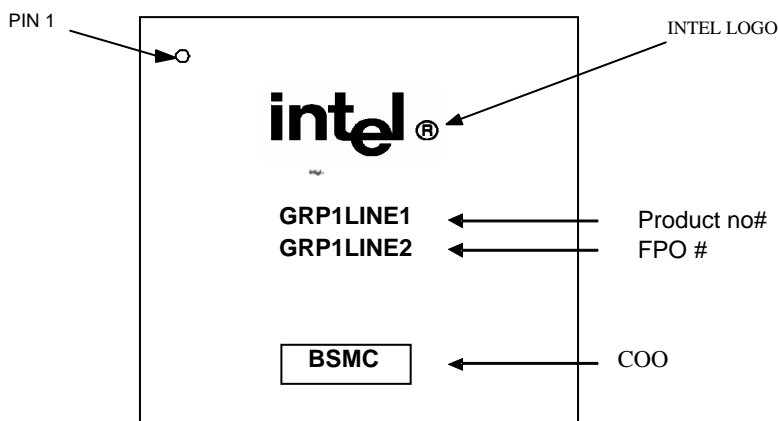

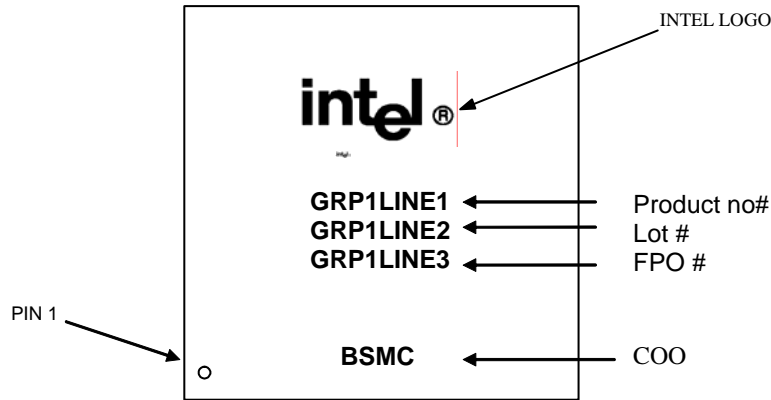
Description of Change to the Customer:

Intel will be standardizing the part mark for the FWLXT9784BC.A4 and FWLXT9784BE.A4. Future mark information for the FWLXT9784 will standardize on the following information: Logo, part number, revision and FPO number. Also note the mark orientation has changed in relationship to Pin One location. The text orientation has rotated 90°, resulting in the pin 1 orientation moving from bottom left corner to top left corner. Please refer to the graphical representation on future mark information below.
