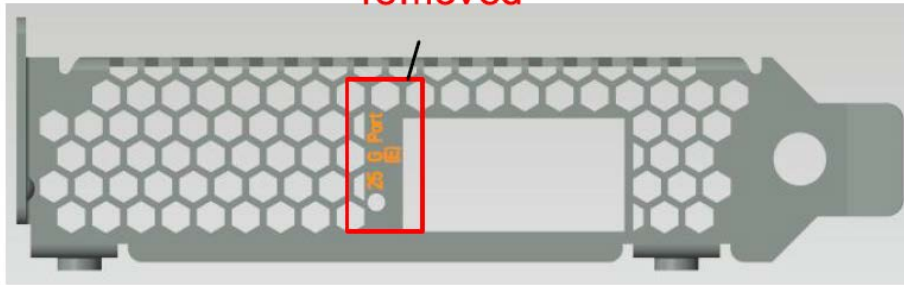


Figure 1: Text to remove from H37764.

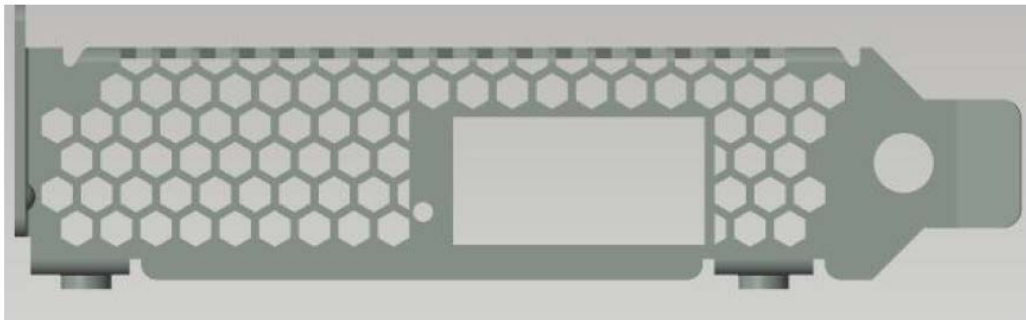


Figure 2: H37764 with no text.
