3. EEPROM update with new NCPA hardware revision ID for tracking purposes. Revision will change from currently shipped 30 to 31.

Customer Impact of Change and Recommended Action:

Reason for Revision: Update the Board Products Table with the current Pre and Post TA and PBA numbers.

Rev 00 Changes

As a result of these changes the customer will receive product with the following changes:

1. C70 & C76 changed from 1uF (0402) capacitor to 10uF (0805) capacitor
2. A PCB change to accommodate the 0805 component footprint (C70 & C76)
3. The EEPROM updated with the new NCPA hardware revision ID for tracking purposes. Revision will change from currently shipped 30 to 31.
4. Dash up of TA # (see Board Products Table)

Samples will be provided on or about October 18, 2006.

Intel will attempt to deplete pre-conversion material before shipping post-conversion material but there is a possibility of Intel shipping mixed inventory. Therefore, customers will need to manage and migrate to the post-conversion material as soon as possible.

Milestone dates are estimates and subject to change based on business and operational conditions.
