### Reason for Revision: Schedule change

SR1530AH; SR1530AHLX

Chassis base - The PCI fan stand-off pins are being moved slightly towards the system board; removing extra standoff that is under center of fan bracket.

Front panel bracket - Increasing the middle portion of front panel bracket to support optical disk drives; slightly enlarging the USB opening for easier plug-in of USB devices; a slight decrease being made to the DVD opening to remove gap with top cover.

Top cover-slight increase being made to the DVD cut-out area to support larger optical disk drives.

PCI fan baffle-- cut 0.5 inch to comply with item 1.

Reduce the height of CD-ROM standoff on base.

Change made to the hard drive left bracket and CD-ROM right bracket for easier installation of the CD-ROM device.

Changes affecting SR1530AHLX and FHJ350WPS only

SR1530AHLX power supply will roll to new 005 version and changes include:

Extend p6 for easily assembling

Extend P7 for easily routing

Add p8 connecter to support slim SATA DVD
