Reason for Revision: Remove SKU from Products Affected table and title

The Intel® JHL8010R USB Retimer, and Intel® JHL8040R Thunderbolt™ 4 Retimer SKUs listed in the Products Affected Table below will have the following change.

The Assembly portion of the manufacturing process is performed today by either Intel's Vietnam site or outsourced via Amkor whereas the Test and Finish portions of manufacturing process are solely done in Vietnam. However, going forward another option for Test/Finish is being introduced. Intel's Malaysia (Kulim) site will begin performing Test/Finish as well. Therefore, customers will see materials shipped to them from either the Vietnam or Malaysia site depending on which site performs the Test/Finish portions of manufacturing.

Customer Impact of Change and Recommended Action:

Intel is considering this a Minor Change and anticipates no impacts to customers for this change. There is no change to the form, fit, functionality, quality or reliability for the products.

All sites performing the Finish portion of the Assembly Manufacturing Process are certified equivalent (form, fit, functional, quality, reliability) for the affected products and/or technologies of this change. There is no change of Assembly site only test and finish.

Customers may see the product shipped to them from either Malaysia or Vietnam. Customer may want to notify their receiving departments to expect shipments from any of the countries mentioned.
