## Description of Change to the Customer:

Intel is updating the BSMI RoHS and BIS URL certificates on Power Supply Units (PSU) as well as updating the PSU label with the marks. Additionally, PSU firmware has been rolled up from 75.9.128 to 78.9.128 in order to improve fan performance when operating at high temperatures and labels updates.

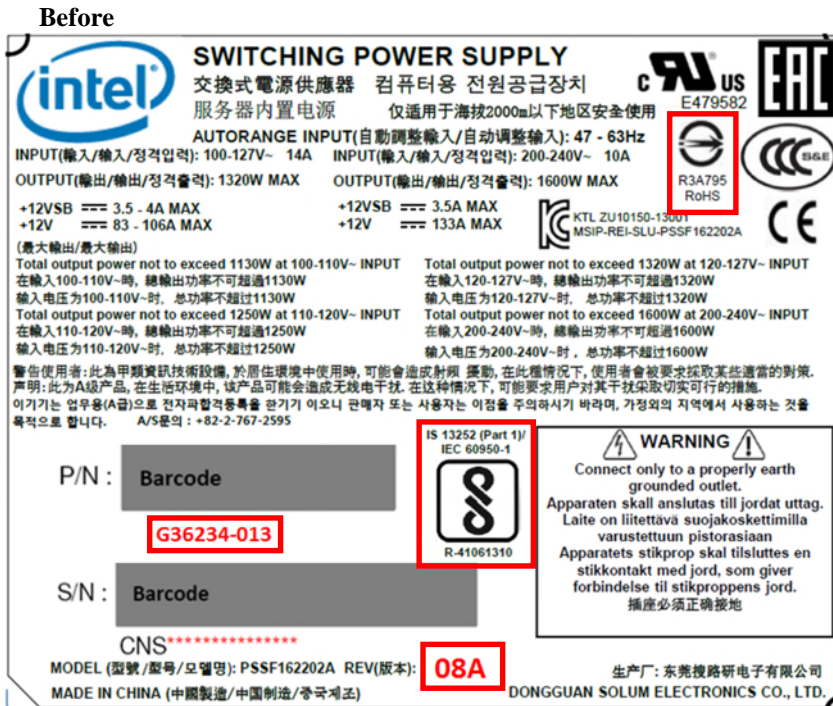


Figure 1. Power Supply Unit Label (Changes in red)

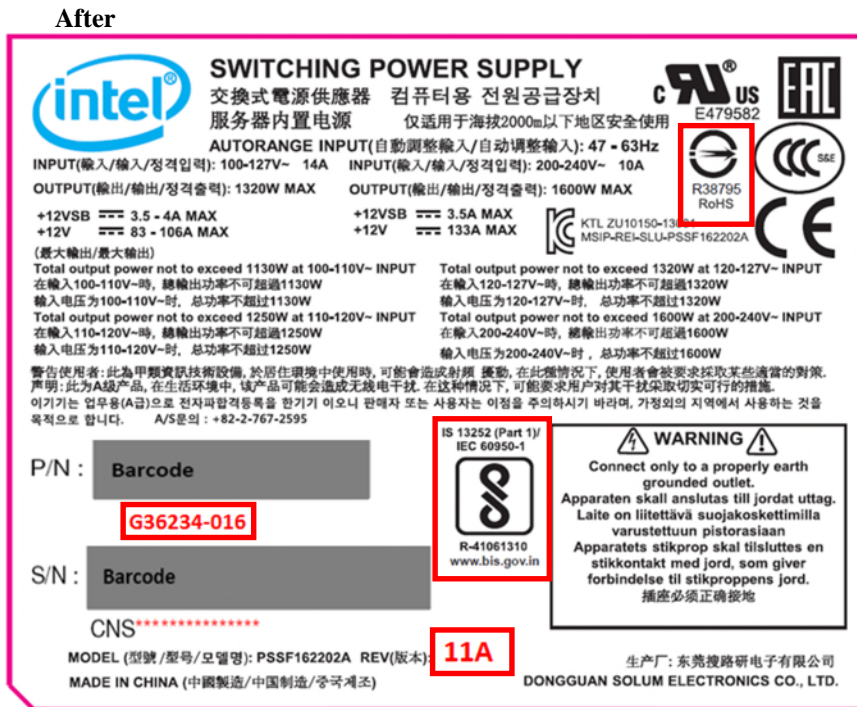


Figure 2. Power Supply Unit Label (Changes in red)
