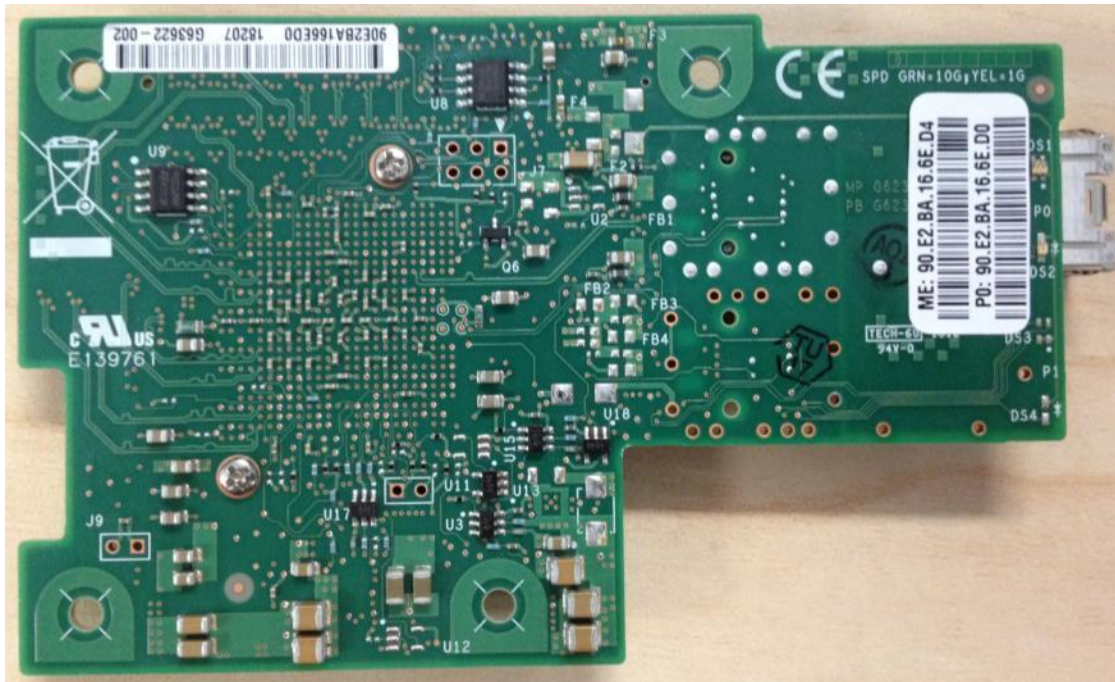

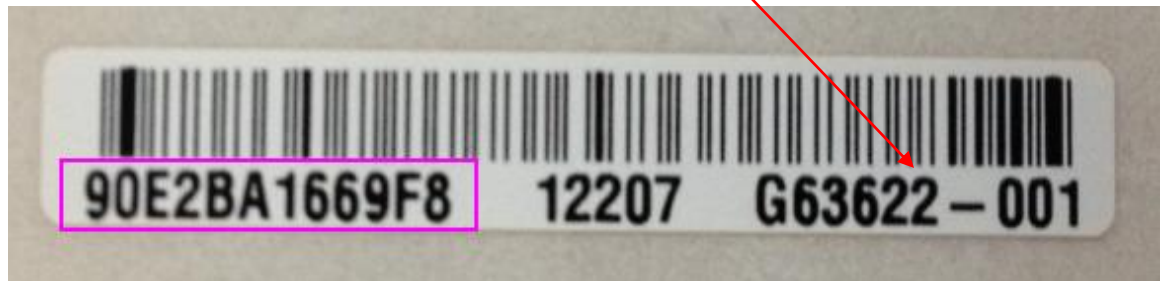
The Intel® Ethernet Server Adapter X520-DA10CP (Davis Flat) FBKX520DA10CP MM# 922586 will undergo the following changes:

- Remove label covering CE mark on PCB.

Example: Picture of PCB with label removed covering CE mark. See below for location of visible CE mark. ****NOTE.** The PBA number, G63622-002, visible on the 3-in-1 label on the board below is not the most current version. It will read G63622-006 after changes are implemented.



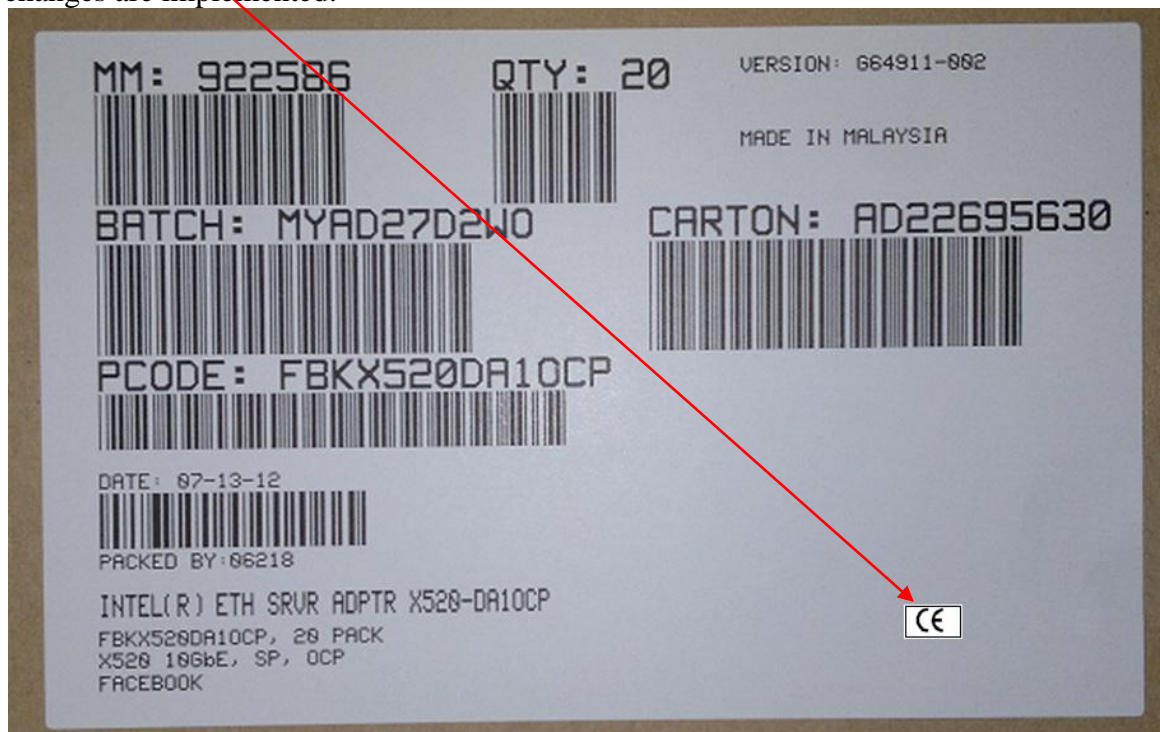
- The Intel 3n1 label will change to reflect the new PBA# (printed board assembly) from G63622-005 to G63622-006, as show in the picture below. (Picture example only)



- Replace current ESD label with a new version that has additional language on the label explaining FCC compliance. See new ESD label sample below.



- Add CE mark to disti label - via separate label that will be affixed to lower, right corner of disti label. ****NOTE.** The TA number, G64911-002, visible on this sample label is not the most current version. It will read G64911-003 after changes are implemented.



As a result of these changes, the PBA (Printed Board Assembly) and the TA (Top Assembly) numbers are new & will replace the current TA & PBA #s, as noted in the affected products table within this PCN notification.
