The depletion of inventory may be impacted by fluctuating supply and demand, therefore, although customers should be prepared to receive the Post-Converted Materials on this date, Intel will continue to ship and customers may continue to receive the pre-converted materials until the inventory has been depleted.*

## Description of Change to the Customer:

In response to customer feedback over the past two years, Intel is deploying a new PCN notification system effective January 1, 2008. The new method, Intel® Quality Document Management System (QDMS,) will replace Intel® Business Link for product change notifications only. All other functionality of Intel® Business Link will remain the same.

The Intel® QDMS will provide significantly improved search capability for product changes and product discontinuances as follows:

1. Date Range
2. PCN number
3. Key Characteristics
4. Product Category
5. Product Code
6. Material Master number
7. Affected S-Spec
8. Customer part number (if available)
9. And more

Customers who currently have an active IBL account will login with their user name and password the same way they login to IBL today.

Direct customers without an IBL account will need to go through their local Intel representative to register for PCN notifications.

There is no change for indirect customers who are currently using the public PCN site.

### **Customer Impact of Change and Recommended Action:**

Customers should access their profile under "My Profile" and set their notification settings. The default setting for notifications is "Web Notification". Customers who wish to be notified via email will need to change their settings to Individual, Daily, or Weekly.
