Curie v4 is moving Test Site from T11 to T90 within the Intel manufacturing network to enable capacity efficiency and optimization. As part of the move Curie v4 will have a new product marking to identify the associated test site. See picture below for reference.

Customer Impact of Change and Recommended Action:

Anticipate no impact to customers on form/fit/function. However the minor change in product marking from "C" to "X" on the FPO lot name will be visible to customers. The intention of the PCN is to provide for informational purposes only. See below picture for reference.



Intel will attempt to deplete pre-conversion material before shipping post-conversion material but there is a possibility of Intel shipping mixed inventory. Therefore, customers will need to manage and migrate to the post-conversion material as soon as possible.
