Description of Change to the Customer:

- Solder side cover changed from A61809-001 to C88612-001.
 - New transparent cover is more durable and rugged compared to the previous black opaque material which was too rigid and prone to tear/break at the faceplate screw edges when flexed.
 - Additional cut-outs have been implemented on the solder cover edge along the front faceplate to improve fitting.
 - Screw mounting holes have been fabricated on the solder side cover to alleviate the need to remove the solder side cover when mounting hard disk drives to the board.
- Addition of Caution Label
Caution label to remind customer of potential board damage if inserted incorrectly into a system. The guide rails can potentially scratch or chafe off certain traces or vias from the side edges of the board if the board is forcefully inserted without proper alignment in the card guides. Carefully align the edges of the board with the card guides in the appropriate slot before sliding the board into the chassis until the injector/ejector mechanism engages the retention bar.
- MAC ID Label Change
Label change as per manufacturing request. Enhanced labels have improved reading recognition at factory process.

Customer Impact of Change and Recommended Action:

Further customer validation may be required but Intel has completed Full Qualification on the changes.
