- Product Change Notification (PCN)
- Product Discontinuance Notification (PDN)
- Product Support Notification (PSN)
- End of Service Notification (ESUN)

Introduction (cont.)

The following features will be available on the Product Change Communication page within RDC

- Web view and Download options for notifications
- Bookmarks for the Product Change Notification page, Bookmarks for individual content, and Bookmarks by Collections
- Bookmark notifications are the mechanism for email notifications within RDC


My Intel Dashboard

 - Users who already had access to QDMS Direct will not need to register a new profile
 - New users will need to register a new profile

Searching for Product Change Notifications

- There are 2 search options available when in the Product Change Notification Content Type view.
 - “Search Intel.com” will search ALL content available based on user’s access on all of RDC
 - “Search this collection” will search only Product Change Notifications published to this Content Type based on user’s access (**recommended option for PCN content**)





How to bookmark by Document

- Users must be logged on to the RDC page to update Bookmarks
- Bookmarking a document will enable notifications to be sent if the document is updated or revised.
- To bookmark a document, click on the Bookmark flag to the right of the document title:





- To unfollow a Bookmarked document, simply uncheck the Bookmark flag. The box will not be solid when the Bookmark is removed.




Managing bookmark notifications

- Users must be logged on to the RDC page to update Bookmarks
- Click on the User icon in the top right corner of the RDC page:

- Content Notifications will be listed
- Product Change Notifications are associated to “My Library: Revised Bookmark”

Confirm Cancel

- Product Change Notification Bookmarks are associated with the My Library: Revised Bookmark option in Inbox Settings
- Checking the Inbox option will post a Bookmark notification on RDC in the “My Intel Dashboard” under Content.
- Checking the Email option will send a Bookmark notification to the users email registered with RDC.
- Frequency options allow how often a Bookmark notification is sent. Options are Immediately, Daily, Weekly, and Monthly.
- Always check “Confirm” when updating Inbox Setting.
