This is a notice to customers that Intel will stop shipping the products listed in this notification into the EU member states, EEA and EFTA because of EU Cyber Resilience Act requirements.

As such, Intel will discontinue shipments into the EU member states, EU EEA and EFTA countries after the last product discontinuance shipment date in the Forecasted Key Milestones above.
