The Intel SKUs listed in the products affected table will have the following changes.

1. Intel will update images being programmed onto all E835 adapters to 2.10 NVM for single and dual port SKU's; and 2.11 NVM for quad port SKU's.

This release enables new features, long term supportability, platform stability, and vSAN certifications.

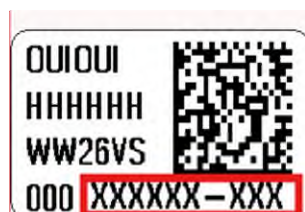
